PRCS-SINDH DELIVERED MEDICAL CARE FOR SURVIVORS OF THE BALOCHISTAN EARTHQUAKE

PRCS-Sindh deployed its Health team in earthquake affected districts of Balochistan. The team consisted of doctors and paramedics with medicines stock of more than one month.

According to the Meteorological Department, the epicentre of the 7.7 magnitude earthquake was 120Km southwest of Khuzdar in Balochistan.

Death toll has risen to 386 and nearly 95 percent houses have been destroyed in a major earthquake that struck

Awaran District of Balochistan.



PRCS-Sindh Branch had activated a control room and started communicating with the district branches adjacent to Balochistan to activate their trained volunteers and staff. A team of PRCS-Sindh Medical Staff (Dr. Muzzummil Pervaiz, Dr. Syed Mohammad, Mohammad Yameen (PeraMed) and Mohammad Irshad (PeraMed)) alongwith a bulk of medicines has deployed to Awaran District. The PRCS NHQ has obtained Helicopter Service from Pakistan Army for the


deployment of medical teams and medicines. The Sindh Branch extended their cooperation and help to the Baluchistan

dispatch.

The medical team based in Awaran district hospital has treated more than 1,300 patients, while two mobile health units of PRCS-Balochistan Branch have been running clinics in the surrounding villages of Labach, Pirandar, Shagazai and Qasimijoe. Each medical team includes four doctors and eight paramedics. As well as treating injuries caused by the earthquake, the teams found that common medical complaints included diarrhoea, malnutrition in children, and complications amongst pregnant women.

PRCS-Sindh Chairperson Mrs. Farzhana Naek appreciated the rapid response and efforts of the medical teams. She said that Red Crescent will make all efforts to

mitigate the suffering of the victims. She further said that the Sindh Branch stands with the victims of the earthquake and will continue supporting the victims and more relief will be provided on need basis. In this regard, PRCS-Sindh also launched donation appeal for Balochistn Earthquake victims.



Mid-Term Lessons Learnt Workshop for Livelihoods Component of PRCS-GRC Sindh Livelihoods Project

In cooperation with Pakistan Red Crescent Society (PRCS), the German Red Cross is operating in Sindh Province specifically in districts Dadu, Thatta and Badin. The overall objective of the project is to contribute to the strengthening of livelihoods strategies of rural



households in the 11 selected villages effected in Floods 2010 through providing support to fishery development, livestock restocking, agricultural inputs supply and institutional capacity building.

At the completion of first Phase of the livestock component for PRCS-GRC Sindh livelihoods Project, a Mid-Term Lessons Learnt workshop was organized by PRCS-Sindh with the support of GRC on 2nd of October, 2013 at Marriott Hotel Karachi. Provincial Secretary PRCS Sindh had inaugurated the workshop.

The purpose of this Mid-Term lessons learned workshop was to adopt the best practices for the next phase by evolving the similar concerns which were addressed by the field staff in workshop. It includes detailed, specific information about behaviours, attitudes, approaches, forms, resources, or protocols that work to the benefit or detriment of projects. Lessons learned represent both the mistakes made on projects and the newer "tricks of the trade" identified during a project effort.

(KMDC) on Saturday, September 14, 2013. Around 250 participants including students and teachers of KMDC attended the First Aid Training and also participated in Quiz Program.

Dr. Rizwana Wasif Training Coordinator of Sindh Red Crescent said that we believe that first aid should be accessible to all - including the most vulnerable, and should also be an integral part of a wider developmental approach. This year the theme is "FIRST AID and Road Safety". She said using this platform we request Government that mandatory the first aid training for everyone who is applying for driving license, students who are passing matriculation and include First Aid Course in education system. Teachers and students actively participated in quiz program and win first aid boxes...

Simulation Exercise on Road Side:

To highlight the importance of Road Safety, the staff of Sindh Red Crescent organized roadside demonstration at Teen Talwar Clifton Karachi. Large number of people took interest to see the rapid response of trained first aid volunteers can save the life of injured. 
